Let's sharpen our skills with the 3Rs: **Recognize, React, and Respond** — the foundation of great prevention. This quick guide brings you back to basics, with fresh tips and smart reminders to help you stay one step ahead.

🔍 Recognize: Stay Sharp, Stay Safe

Always keep an eye out—especially during busy times or group entries.

👀 Heads Up, Eyes Forward

Say hi and make eye contact. Show you're aware and attentive.

Open with "What brings you in today?"

🚩 Spot the Red Flags

Watch for behaviors like hanging around luxury products, bags from other malls, or distraction attempts.

🟡 If You Can't See Their Face, It's Time to Stay Alert

Hoods, hats, and unnecessary masks may be signs someone's trying to hide.

安保 Security: Mall Walk-Throughs Work

Ask for frequent, random, visits as security presence can be a powerful deterrent.

👉 React: Be Present, Be Proactive

Your movement and presence on the floor are your first lines of defense.

🟢 Clean Store, Clear Message

A tidy space shows control—and makes theft harder. Keep the shelves filled and the counters empty.

💬 Check In, Calmly and Confidently

If something feels off, re-engage with service to reset the tone.

🤝 Respond: Communication Is Your Superpower

Talk with teammates. Share suspicions. Use codes if needed.

📢 Speak Up in the Rush

Even short phrases like "I just sold that" or "I'll be right back" keep eyes moving and deter theft.

🔴 Don't Wait — Call the Police Fast

If it fits protocol (over \$1000, selection and concealment is confirmed on video), contact the police.

📘 Know the Protocol Before You Need It

Preparation matters. Be ready to act with clarity and confidence.
