### Q: What does Champions for Sight do?

Champions for Sight offer a 360-degree approach, the program contains *three components* that all work together to fuel the cycle of charitable impact:



**Raising Awareness:** You will receive turn-key marketing materials that will help *educate patients* on the importance of vision care.



**Programming:** Once registered, you will be able to equip under-resourced patients with *exams and glasses at no cost*. Note eyeglasses provided through OneSight's charitable portal (frame kit) and EssilorLuxottica's lab network.



**Fundraising:** You can accept *donations at their registers* when tendering in Ciao! Optical to fund this charitable work.
